In the online database it is possible to find a wide variety of items such as Audiovisual Materials, Multimedia and Maps; Dictionaries, Biographical dictionaries and Encyclopaedias; Books, Monographs and Manuscripts; Newspapers, Periodicals and Magazines; Catalogues, Proceedings, Guidebooks and Yearbooks; Bulletins, Supplements and Miscellany; Dissertations, Studies and Papers; Web documents and Websites.

3. How does the search box of BIB-CEC works
